



Code of Ethics

As a member of the Missouri Funeral Directors and Embalmers Association, I recognize my obligation to members of the public, my clients, the community and the profession to fully comply with all applicable State and Federal laws and regulations. I believe that I have an obligation to provide the public the highest degree of ethical conduct consistent with those laws and regulations. In addition, I agree to abide by the following ethical principles for the purpose of assuring that the public, in all its dealings with my establishment, will receive service according to the highest ethical standard:

1. I will faithfully conduct myself in my practice to the best of my knowledge and ability, serving each family with integrity and a professional and caring manner, being respectful of their wishes and confidences, being honest and fair in all dealings with them and being considerate of those of lesser means.
2. I will provide services to families without regard to religion, race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or disability.
3. I will care for each deceased person with the highest respect and dignity and will transport, prepare and give shelter to the remains in a professional, caring and conscientious manner.
4. I will never knowingly engage in any conduct that misleads or deceives the public. I will comply fully with all the laws and regulations relating to my profession and comply fully with the Code of Ethics of the Missouri Funeral Directors and Embalmers Association to operate and maintain high moral and ethical standards of honesty and dealings with the public.
